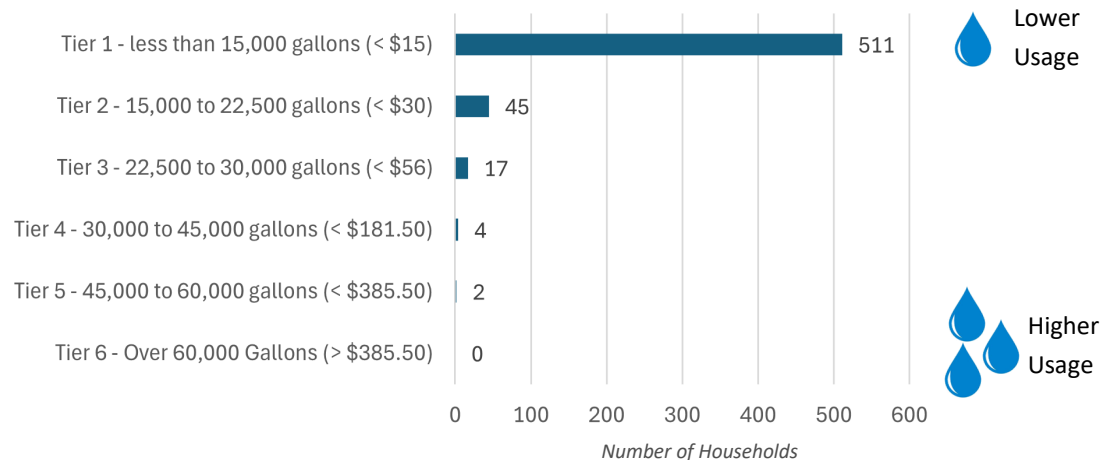

NOTE: Water used within the first tier is the least expensive. If a customer's water use exceeds the limit of the first tier, subsequent water use is charged at a higher, second tier rate. This continues on up to the sixth tier.

WHEN TEMPERATURES STAY BELOW FREEZING: ❄️


 **Give pipes a helping hand**
❄️ If pipes run through cabinets or vanities, open the doors to let warmer room temperatures flow in.

 **Keep water working**
❄️ Keep water moving through the pipes by allowing a small trickle of water to run. The cost of the extra water is typically lower than the cost of repairing a broken pipe.

BUT IF YOUR PIPES DO FREEZE: ❄️

 **Shut off the water immediately**
Don't attempt to thaw pipes without turning off the main shut-off valve.

 **Thaw pipes with warm air**
You can melt the frozen water in the pipe by warming the air around it with a hair dryer or space heater. Be sure not to leave space heaters unattended and avoid the use of kerosene heaters or open flames.

 **Be careful turning water back on**
❄️ Once pipes are thawed, slowly turn the water back on and check pipes and joints for any cracks or leaks that might have been caused by freezing.
